

# **Ingredients**

1 head broccoli, chopped

1 head cauliflower chopped

1 cup mayonnaise

1 cup sour cream

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 pound bacon, fried and crumbled

1 cup cheddar cheese, shredded

## **Optional Ingredients**

Raisins for added sweetness

Thinly sliced or finely chopped red onion

Sunflower seeds for a nutty flavor

Shredded carrot or chopped bell pepper for extra color and nutrition

#### Directions

- 1. Combine chopped broccoli and cauliflower in a large bowl
- 2. Mix mayonnaise, sour cream, sugar, and salt in a separate bowl
- 3. Add the dressing to the broccoli-cauliflower mix and stir to coat
- 4. Stir in bacon and cheese reserving some for topping
- 5. Refrigerate for at least 30 minutes to allow flavors to blend
- 6. Top with reserved bacon and cheese before serving
