Supported Employment IPS Principles:

- Zero Exclusion Policy No one is excluded for reasons such as symptoms, substance use, poor work history, etc.
- **Preferences are Key** Preferences lay the groundwork for the job search.
- Rapid Job Search Employment specialists help make contact with employers and the individual sets the pace.
- A Competitive Job is the Goal A
 job that pays at least minimum wage,
 is in the community, and is open to
 anyone.
- Employment Integrated with Mental Health Services - Teams talk regularly, to share expertise, and plan services.
- Time-Unlimited Support Follow along as needed to: problem solve, self-manage, get feedback, job changes, etc.
- Personalized Benefits Planning -Assure accurate information about earned income and impact on benefits.
- Employment Staff Systematically develops relationships with employers in the community based on participant preference.

The Harbor Individual Placement Support (IPS) program is an evidence-based option perfect for those who may need more support and see work as an important part of their recovery. To be eligible, client must have presence of a severe and persistent or co-occurring mental health issue and Medicaid insurance.

Through IPS, the employment specialist offers stronger, more coordinated support and is regularly involved, if that is what is needed. With a desire to work, the employment specialist will help identify preferences, interests, personal goals, and a job goal. Supports are ongoing and services are more intensive as an individual builds the skills to succeed at work.
